In case of play-off runner up also having existing team in Elite, losing semi-finalist teams would be next in order to be promoted based on points standings during regular season. Tie breaker rules would apply as necessary.		
<b><u>First Division ( Maximum Two teams per club in this division )</u></b>		
First three teams from each conference moved to the Playoff		
<b>Playoff champion and Number 1 Division team from regular season will promoted to PREMIER</b>		
<b>Last two teams from the division will be demoted to SECOND division.</b>		
In case play-off winner already has team in Premier, play-off runner up will be promoted.		
In case of play-off runner up also having existing team in Premier, losing semi-finalist teams would be next in order to be promoted based on points standings during regular season. Tie breaker rules would apply as necessary.
